

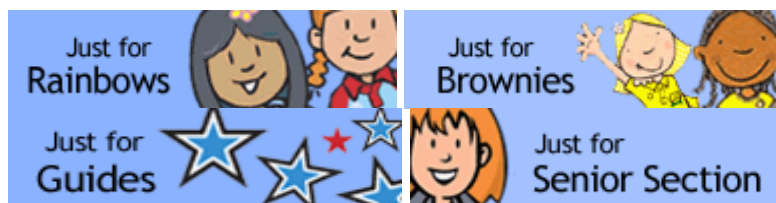
Guiding News

Guiding celebrates its centenary in 2010 and in September 2009 the celebrations will be launched.
